Discussion

Old Business:

- --Chipotle fundraiser: Over \$600 raised.
- --Restaurant Nights: plan to try and have one each month next year, maybe break it down by grade levels.
- --Book Fair: would like 2 registers next year, will buy books for the library with the earnings: approximately \$6,000 worth.
- --International Night: suggestions made to get notice further out, won't have it on a long weekend next year.

- --Field Day: Ms. Skordahl requested \$75 to buy flavors for snow cones and inflatables, will need volunteers June 7 from 10-3 to serve snow cones.

- -School Safety: Suggestions to add motion-sensing lights to the back doors, signs saying "You're being watched," teaching emotional regulation/anger management in leadership classes, having staff prepared for what to do in a lockdown, teaching the Restorative Justice Model, have more training for staff on "warning signs" in students, having school buddies between older and younger grades to build community, sending a letter home to parents with educational info and reminders to keep guns locked, adding fencing in back of school, working with YSB (Youth Service Bureau).
- -Science Night: coming up on May 11, will include Bell Museum, Dodge Nature Center, and Kyle's Reptiles, PTO helping fund \$275, discussed possibly doing concessions.
- **-Uniform Swap:** no date planned for next swap, but old uniforms can be dropped off at the office anytime.
- --Teacher Appreciation Week: coming up the week of May 8, the PTO tries to do a little something each day for the staff, ideas discussed include students/parents sending staff

emails/notes of thanks, root beer float day, sharpies/office supplies gifts, catering a meal one day, giving little vases of flowers one day, coffee bar/tea.
